
Header Annotations

- 1. You can add annotations at the top of any document.
- 2. Click the **New Annotation** icon on the righthand toolbar and then enter your note into the text box at the top. You can format your text and include live links.
- 3. These annotations can only be viewed by you unless you choose to share them.
- 4. If you have appropriate permissions, you can share annotations with individuals or groups of people within your organisation.



Inline Annotations

- 1. You can add **Inline Annotations** throughout the text of any document.
- 2. Use your mouse cursor to click and drag over a section of text and a pop-up will appear.
- You can choose to add an Inline Annotation, save this section of text into a folder, highlight the text, or copy the extract with or without its reference (citation and date of copying).



Show or Hide All Annotations

- 1. If you have annotated a document, the Show/Hide Annotations icon on the righthand toolbar will indicate the total number of Header and Inline annotations.
- 2. You can click this icon to show or hide your annotations.
