

How To Access Cases

- 1. Accessing Cases by Jurisdiction:
 - Go to the Asia Home Page
 - Select the Jurisdiction Malaysia
 - Then, choose Case Law as the content type
- 2. Accessing Cases by Content type:
 - Go to the Asia Home Page
 - Select Case Law as the Content type
 - Then, choose the Jurisdiction Malaysia





Advanced Search Template

The Advanced Search Template provides search fields specific to cases. Enter keywords into one or more fields to find the required cases. For helpful advice on searching, click Search Tips in the top right corner.

- 1. Click on **Advanced** next to the search bar to display the Advanced Search Template which provides various search field options.
- 2. For helpful advice on making your search more effective, click on **Search Tips** in the top right corner.
- Use one or more of the search fields in the Advanced Search Template to refine your search.
- 4. Include **Connectors and Expanders** to increase the efficacy of the search.






Cases Guide

Searching Malaysia Cases

This example demonstrates how to find Malaysia Cases relating to "insolvency" and "striking out" that also cites the "Bankruptcy Act".

- 1. Navigate to the Malaysia Advanced Search template for Cases, as explained above.
- Type insolvency /255 "striking out" in the Key Search Terms search field.
 Note: The /N connector will locate the search terms within 255 words of each other
 The quotation marks will ensure "striking out" is found as an exact phrase.
- 3. Type Bankruptcy Act 1967 in the Legislation Title field.
- 4. Click **Search** or press Enter.
